- Club alignment Possesses excellent technical and tactical knowledge and coaching skills aligned to HBCAFC's playing and coaching philosophies.
- Coaching quality Proven ability to plan, organise and deliver high-quality coaching and training sessions to prepare teams for the tournament.
- Leadership and mentorship Leading positively by example and being a role model to our youth players.
- Communication and organisation Effectively communicate to all those involved in the programme players, coaches, staff, parents and club members and organise a successful tournament programme for all involved.





- Build effective working relationships ability to work successfully with others and show an ability to build and continue effective relationships with others
- Management proven track record as an effective leader of players and people.
- Experience proven track record as a successful coach of youth and/or senior teams in this capacity.
- Invested and passionate An unquestionable passion for football, the club, and a strong desire to build a successful squad that sees HBCAFC compete successfully and consistently at the highest level.
- Development proven ability to develop youth and experienced players into a cohesive environment fostering the talent of HBCAFC.

The Head Coach will be responsible for:

- Planning, implementation, management and success of their respective U19 representative team reporting directly to the General Manager of HBCAFC.
- Determining the playing model to be implemented.
- Identification and recruitment of players.
- Identifying and organising their coaching and support staff to support their team environment.

Mandatory requirements:

- Eligible to work in New Zealand
- Undergo a Police Check
- Current First Aid certificate

Non-essential requirements that may support your application:

- Current coaching license / qualifications
- Current coach or player at the club with a vested interested and commitment beyond this event or programme





Other responsibilities and details:

- Oversee and manage the recruitment, management, coaching, selection and performances of the U19 team squad.
- Utilise footage and data to accurately create development plans and session plans for the team.
- Manage the staff that are allocated to the team squads in a professional and inclusive manner.
- Be professional and a role model leader towards all stakeholders within HBCAFC and the wider community.
- Experience in coaching teams within the New Zealand (Auckland landscape is preferable).
- Proven ability and record in coaching successful, well-organised football teams with strong team culture.

These positions are unpaid, however all reasonable costs incurred will be reimbursed following approval from the club's General Manager.
