Looking for something to do during lockdown - follow Hibernian FC in the Scottish Premier League! You may or may not be aware, but Hibiscus Coast AFC was founded by some travelling Scottish including our founding Club President Clarrie Morgan, who had strong ties with the Hibernian Football Club.

Hibernian FC is commonly known as Hibs, compete in the Scottish Premier League (currently sitting 1st) and is based in the Leith area of Edinburgh. It was founded by Edinburgh's Irish community in 1875 and was the first British Club to participate in the European Cup in 1955. They become Scottish champions in 1903 with the golden period during the 1940' and 1950's. They have certainly got this season off to a flyer!

Some well-known International footballers from the club include Gordon Smith, Bobby Jonstone, Lawrie Reilly, Eddie Turnball, Willie Ormond, Joe Baker and Pat Stanton. Like us Hibs are immensely proud of their Club and loyal to their roots.
