

ALL FIFA RULES APPLY, WITH THE FOLLOWING EXCEPTIONS OR MODIFICATIONS.

- A) <u>Teams will consist of 7 players, with a limit of 10</u> members per squad.
 B) A match may not start if either team consists of fewer than 4 players.
 C) For Mixed competition there must be <u>at least 3 female</u> players on the field at all times
 D) Defaulted games will result in a 3-0 loss for the defaulting team.
 E) If both teams default the match will be recorded as a 0-0 draw. No points will be awarded to either team.
 F) If a player plays for one team, he or she is not eligible to play for another team in the same competition group.
- 2. a) Substitutions can occur at any time and are unlimited. <u>Roll on roll off subs.</u>
 b) Substitutes must enter from halfway and can only enter the field once the substitute player has left the field, also at halfway.
 c) Referee must be notified of any substitution.

A free kick from the halfway line will be awarded against any team not complying with the substitution rule.

- 3. Games shall start and finish at the blast of the hooter. <u>Games shall be 20 minutes</u> <u>each half. Therefore, games shall be 40 minutes in total with immediate turn</u> <u>around at half time.</u>
- 4. Each team will play 1 *game per night*, managers will be responsible for finding out where games are taking place and for getting teams to the start of the games on time.
- **5.** All players shall wear suitable footwear. <u>*No screw-in or metal studs will be allowed.*</u> Moulded soles are acceptable. <u>*Shin pads are compulsory.*</u>
- 6. Players are allowed inside the goal box area.
- 7. The Goalie is allowed out of the goal box area.
- 8. You may pass the ball back to the keeper, **but** the keeper cannot handle the ball with their hands if passed back by their own player.
- 9. Games include *corners one-step kick*.
- 10. *No slide-tackles* shall be permitted. If committed, a direct free kick shall be awarded from where the tackle took place.
- 11. Any player or players are allowed within the goal box.
- 12. <u>A ball leaving the goal box at any time cannot go over halfway without touching</u> <u>the ground or a player</u>. A free kick is awarded on the halfway line to the opposing team. This applies to goal kicks, throws (GK), and passes back.



13. <u>No offside rule</u>

- 14. <u>When the ball goes over the side-line play shall be restarted with a kick-in.</u> This is a push pass, one foot by the ball the other foot "pushes" the ball into play. The ball must be played along the ground. <u>A goal cannot be scored direct from a kick-in</u>.
- 15. *For all restarts of play* (kick off, free kick, kick-in, goal-kick, corner etc) <u>opponents must stand a minimum of 3 meters</u> from where the kick is being taken.
- 16. <u>Yellow card /sin-bin</u> If a player is sin-binned, they must wait behind their own goal. A sin-bin offence is the equivalent of a yellow card. This includes indecent or unsporting behaviour and persistent time wasting. <u>Sin-bin duration will be 3</u> <u>minutes</u>. During this time, the sin-binned player's team will be down by 1 player. (<u>Players in the sinbin cannot be subbed.</u>)
- 17. <u>Red card/Sending off</u> This will result in a minimum of a <u>one week ban and</u> <u>further action may be taken by the disciplinary committee</u>. *Red card offences include* serious foul play, striking or attempting to strike an opponent/referee, spitting at an opponent/referee, foul, or abusive language, or receiving a second caution (yellow card.)
- 18. A penalty kick is awarded against a team that commits an offence for which a direct free kick is awarded, inside its own penalty area and while the ball is in play. Penalty kick will be taking 7 feet from the goal line.
- 19. <u>Managers will be responsible for the behaviour of players, parents & supporters</u>. Any side-line behaviour which needs to be addressed will be brought to the attention of the team manager by the referee/club official. If the behaviour is not addressed the referee/club official will terminate the game and the case will be studied by the club's disciplinary committee.
- 20. <u>The club's disciplinary committee reserves the right to expel any player or team from the competition without refund</u>.
